
Context and Challenges in health and healthcare







Fig. 4.2 Varying standards of care over time

Care for older people

- Transitions in needs, support and assistance
- Appropriate treatments and advance care timely
- Autonomy and personal preferences and goals
- (Cap)ability and Quality of life



Advanced (dementia) care

- Avoid transitions as moments of crisis,
 - hospital admission, changes in living environment, increased dependence; sense of self identity ...
- Avoid inappropriate or unwanted interventions and unplanned moves.
- Preplanning can improve the quality of life and death experience
- Older persons, family and friends can feel excluded or disempowered, at times of crisis or transition.

Team climate & healthy work environment




Outcomes (what): dependent on populations and vulnerabilities

APN in older people

- *Multidisciplinary*, patient education, multidimensional assessments and coordination of multiple providers.
- disease-oriented practice using evidence-based interventions to control risks and complications or
- *generalist practice* focused on improving the autonomy of patients with multiple conditions.
- reduced readmissions, increased patients' and caregivers' satisfaction.
